Women's Center Re-opens Slowly After Fire

The kitchen at Marin Services for Women is still working after three small fires over the weekend damaged the Greenbrae nonprofit agency on South Eliseo Drive.

Ann Harrison, executive director for Marin Services for Women, which offers treatment for drug dependent women and their families, said yesterday inspectors allowed residents to return to the facility.

Red Robin, a Larkspur restaurant and catering business, is letting the center prepare meals at its facility and store perishable items in its freezers and refrigerators.

Harrison said she expects the kitchen to be operational by Monday. She said damage might top \$100,000. Nearly 30 residential clients have been allowed back in the facility. They were evacuated early Sunday morning and stayed at the Courtyard by Marriot at Larkspur Landing.
